- (7) Failure to contest the validity or enforcement of the registered order (or of the order claimed to be the controlling order) in a timely manner:
- will result in confirmation and enforcement of the registered order and the claimed arrears; and
  - precludes further contest about any matter that could have been asserted.
- (8) At a hearing you may:
- seek to vacate the registration;
  - assert a defense to a claim that you did not comply with the registered order; and
  - contest the remedies being sought or the amount of the claimed arrears.
- (9) At a hearing you may present evidence to prove that:
- the issuing tribunal did not have personal jurisdiction over you;
  - the order was obtained by fraud;
  - the order has been vacated, suspended, or modified by a later order;
  - the issuing tribunal has stayed the order pending appeal;
  - there is a defense under the law of this state to the remedy sought;
  - full or partial payment has been made;
  - the statute of limitation under Utah Code Section 78B-14-604 precludes enforcement of some or all of the claimed arrears; and
  - the claimed controlling order is not the controlling order.
